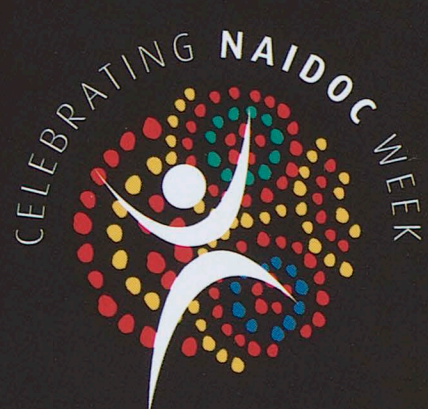

Dreaming stories are presented as elaborate song cycles (Songlines) that relate to a specific place, group or individual. Dreamtime ancestors made Songlines as part of the creation story to provide a map of the landscape, and represent the relationship between the lands, the seas and the people. The painting represents all of the Songlines coming together to create our nation. You can see how they criss-cross the land as they run East, West, North, South and diagonally across the country to track the journeys of our ancestors.
